## **New Wages Guides July 2019**

Members were notified on 30 May 2019 that a decision of the Fair Work Commission awarded a 3% wage increase to adult minimum award rates of pay. This means that from the first complete pay period commencing on or after **1 July 2019**, the award minimum wage rates will increase. Employers should make sure that that they pay their employees at least the minimum rates.

## Absorb wages into existing over-award wage payments

The increase is to be fully absorbed into any existing over-award rates of pay. Employers who pay their employees more than the minimum rate of pay [for example the new current rate of \$862.50 for a tradesperson level (6)], then the increase will **not** apply.
