ACCC change to vehicle and component recall advice

VACC members are advised that from 1 July, that vehicle recalls will no longer be published by the Australian Competition and Consumers Commission (ACCC).

Who will publish the new information?

From 1 July 2021 the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Communication (DIRDC) will be the Regulator under the new Road Vehicle Standards laws.

What about previous recall information?

Previous information regarding vehicle and component recalls that were supplied by the ACCC under the Product Safety Australia website will be transitioned to the DIRDC website by 1 September 2021.

So how do you check for a recall?

When a vehicle or component is recalled we DIRDC will publish a recall notice to the [Vehicle Recalls website](#). You can also enter your vehicle's details on this website to see if it is currently affected by any active recall.
