Geelong Industry Roundtable Consultation

VACC Members were recently advised that over the next two years the Andrews Labor government will examine how regulation is impacting Victoria's small businesses.

To inform itself of areas where Victorian based legislation and regulation is creating red tape issues for small business, the Minister for Small Business, Trade and Innovation, the Hon Philip Dalidakis MP, launched a Government Wide Small Business Regulation Review (the Review).

VACC members are encouraged to take the opportunity to inform the Government of instances where red tape emanating from state based legislation or regulation is impacting their business. The review should identify examples of regulation that are redundant, complex or repetitive in their application.

Geelong and Western District based members will have an opportunity to inform the Government at the second of a series of Small Business Office facilitated 'Industry Roundtable Consultations'.
