Make the move now to creating roadworthies online

I am writing to encourage you to make the move to VicRoads' online system for creating roadworthy certificates.

The VACC is strongly supportive of the eRWC system. We have kept in close contact with its development and rollout to the industry – we believe it's an efficient, streamlined system with many benefits for Licensed Vehicle Testers. The feedback we have been receiving from our LVT Committee and the industry more broadly has been positive overall.

We understand that making a smooth transition from using the paper roadworthy books to the online system without significant interruption to their business is a key concern for some businesses. The VACC has spoken to VicRoads about how they can support LVTs to make this transition.

VicRoads advised that they can offer full assistance with the onboarding process. They can also provide onsite training for your workshop to help you familiarise yourself with the online system.

If you have already signed up to the eRWC system, that's fantastic. If not, the VACC encourages you to take advantage of VicRoads' offer of full assistance and make the move now before it becomes mandatory, which we understand will be July 2022. We are confident you will see the benefits once you do.
