## **Licensed Vehicle Testers Industry Survey**

Dear Member

The VACC LVT focus group works collaboratively with VicRoads vehicle safety and compliance team to ensure the roadworthy e-Certificate program is fit for purpose. As a result, there have been many enhancements implemented as well as the identification and removal of software bugs resulting in an industry wide rollout in Victoria.

Meanwhile, the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 2009 have been replaced by the Road Safety (Vehicles) Interim Regulations 2020. These interim regulations commenced on 4 October 2020 and will remain in place for a period of 12 months. The focus group was actively involved during consultations with the Victorian Department of Transport and is pleased with some of the outcomes such as introduction of an internal review process and the second inspection period stretching out to 14 days.

The LVT focus group continues to monitor industry non-compliance rates, advocate for better testing standards, and review complaints made to VACC where VicRoads has made a decision to cancel or suspend an LVT license.
