# Calling for Expressions of Interest to join VicRoads' Technical Review panel for VASS disputes

VicRoads is calling for Expressions of Interest from suitably qualified engineers to be part of an independent technical panel to provide review and assessment services in relation to the certification of vehicle modifications.

The panel will be required to provide these services in circumstances where there is a technical dispute between VicRoads and a VASS provider.

The independent technical review panel will consist of three (3) qualified members.

#### Selection criteria

- 1. Applicants must not be current VASS Signatories;
- 2. Applicants must be recognised by the SAE as degree qualified engineers with a minimum of 10 years' experience in the Automotive or Heavy Vehicle industries; and
- 3. Applicants must be familiar with the application of vehicle design and engineering standards

### Scope of services

The role of the independent technical panel:

- a. examine all the evidence contained within the Work Review file;
- b. prepare a written report outlining the findings including substantiated statements that support any conclusions; and
- c. provide a recommendation on compliance to the relevant guidelines and regulations
