The National Heavy Vehicle Regulator (NHVR) is seeking feedback on their draft [Heavy Vehicle Safety Strategy 2021-2025](#), which sets out their strategic ambitions to improve heavy vehicle safety outcomes (including a reduction in crashes, fatalities and serious injury).

The draft Heavy Vehicle Safety Strategy 2021-2025 is aligned to the draft National Road Safety Strategy 2021-2030 (NRSS), which sets out Australia's road safety objectives, key priorities for action, and road trauma reduction targets to 2030.

Specifically, NHVR is seeking input on the following:

- Their approach to partnerships.
- Creating positive change in individual behaviours and industry culture to improve safety.
- Driving uptake of modern, safer heavy vehicle fleet that reduces the likelihood and impact of crashes.
- Influencing road network design to support safe heavy vehicle use.
