Consumer Affairs Victoria (CAV) has released its proposed Professional Engineers Registration (Fees) Regulations 2021 (proposed Fees Regulations) and the Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) prepared for those Regulations for consultation.

The Regulations

The proposed Regulations prescribe:

- fees for the registration of professional engineers and applications for other services to the Business Licensing Authority (BLA)
- refunds of certain fees, and
- exemptions from the payment of annual endorsement fees in certain circumstances.

Fees are proposed for applications for:

- registration and renewal of registration
- endorsement and renewal of endorsement
- an annual endorsement statement
- adding an area of registration to an existing registration, and
- searching, taking a copy of and obtaining a certified copy or extract of the register of professional engineers to be maintained by the BLA.
