As you would be aware, the Automotive Transformation Scheme ends in December 2020.

Historically the ATS (and its predecessor ACIS) has been the key incentive package from the Federal government to support the Australian automotive manufacturing industry.

Moving forward, given the impending cessation of the ATS, organisations in the automotive supply chain should be thinking about the potential transition from ATS to the R&D Tax Incentive if they are still conducting R&D.

The two schemes are very different, requiring careful consideration of timing, eligibility and potential clawback provisions between the two schemes.

There is also a range of other prescribed government grant programs that manufacturers should be considering in relation to their future investment.
