NHVAS Fees Increase

On Monday, 15 October 2018, NHVAS accreditation fees will increase.

According to a recent bulletin released by NHVR,
"Since 10 February 2014, the NVHR has been the single administrator of the NHVAS. The NHVR has administered the scheme using a single fee structure for all states and territories. While other fees within the NHVR have increased each year, NHVAS fees have remained the same."

Consequently, the current fees are considered to inadequately reflect the true administrative cost.

A table of the new costs is included below:

Maintenance management	\$27 per vehicle	\$32 per vehicle

Members are advised that NHVAS fees may increase the same way as other NHVR services; on 1 July each year in line with CPI.
