Chain of Responsibility Information Session

Dear Members

As many of you will be aware, on 1 October 2018, the Heavy Vehicle National Law (HVNL) will be modified to ensure each participant in the heavy vehicle transport supply chain is responsible for the safety of their transport activities.

Also known as the Chain of Responsibility (CoR), its function is to minimise harm or loss by ensuring supply chain participants play their part by implementing safe business practices.

The National Heavy Vehicle Regulator (NHVR) is holding industry information sessions across the country to explain the changes to CoR, the impact on your business and how a Safety Management System can help you effectively manage your operations' safety risks.
