I am pleased to announce the recent launch of VACC's federal policy document: REvolution – The automotive industry's policy priorities for the next Australian Government.

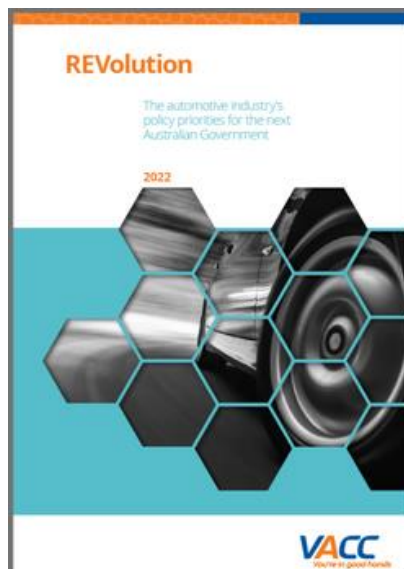
