VACC's own Nigel Muller is a member of the Industry Reference Committee, a body tasked with identifying the training needs of the retail, service, and repair sector of the automotive industry.

This nationally endorsed qualification reflects the role of individuals who service, diagnose, and repair battery electric vehicles and includes 30 units of competencies, 17 core and 13 elective catering for either light or heavy vehicles.
