Dear Members

Please be advised that there is to be a change to the process for registering new vehicles from 1 July 2021.

Upcoming Commonwealth legislative changes will require vehicle dealers to make a change to the way they register new road vehicles.

What is the change?

- From 1 July 2021, evidence of a vehicle's compliance with the Standards for Registration will no longer be sourced from a vehicle's compliance plate.
- Over the 12 months to 1 July 2022, compliance plates will be phased out.
