Digital Drivers Licences and the LMCT

About digital driver licenses and your dealership

Your dealership will soon have customers showing you their licence on their mobile phone.

This may impact how you identify a person for the purposes of retailing a new or used motor vehicle or collect information for other purposes such as test drives.
