If you are located along the northeast link build and have received a letter of compulsory acquisition from the government, please be aware that VACC is here to help, particularly with relocation and transfer of licenses such as VicRoads (LVT's), ARCTick air-conditioning licenses or employment matters.

VACC is in discussions with the Northeast Link Project Team (NELP) and is advocating for better support packages for members. Let us know if you have been adversely impacted or if you would like to raise any issues. Please note, this does not include any legal advice.

Support available from NELP includes:

- business relocation and marketing advice, business development and mentoring, promotion of goods and services on Gov procurement panels, translation and counselling services.
