The Victorian Small Business Commission (VSBC) has updated its website with information to further help small business tenants in asking for rent relief from their landlord under the extended Commercial Tenancy Relief Scheme.

The VSBC now offers examples to clarify what tenants need to provide to prove that they're taking part in JobKeeper (<u>click here</u>) – their Business Registration for JobKeeper Wage Subsidy ATO receipt number **and** a copy of their most recent notice to the ATO under the JobKeeper Rules.

To help tenants who choose to show their decline in turnover by supplying a business activity statement, we've provided an example of the ATO's form, highlighting the section asking for G1 information (total sales) that needs to be completed (see above link).
