Federal Government announces \$100 million Advanced Manufacturing Fund

Dear Members

The Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science, Senator the Hon Arthur Sinodinos AO announced this morning that the Federal Government will add a **new \$100 million Advanced Manufacturing Fund**.

According to the Minister's media release, the package includes:

- \$47 million for a new Advanced Manufacturing Growth Fund (over two years). This is in addition to the \$155 million existing Growth Fund designed to assist the wind-down of the car industry.
- \$4 million for the Advanced Manufacturing Growth Centre (over two years).
- \$20 million under the Cooperative Research Centre Projects initiative (over two years). This
 includes funding of large scale advanced manufacturing research projects up to \$3 million (over
 three years).
- \$10 million to establish **Innovation Labs** in South Australia and Victoria (including test center facilities and business capability). These will be delivered through existing government services such as the Entrepreneurs' Programme, Industry Growth Centers and Austrade.
- \$5 million to invest in engineering student research.
- \$13.5 million **tariff reduction** on imported vehicle prototypes and components used by Australian motor vehicle design and engineering services.

I will be looking at each of these spends in more detail after the Federal Budget has been handed down tomorrow evening.
