HFC Phase Down Information Session - Register to Attend

The Australian Government has acted on its commitment to reduce the use of hydrofluorocarbons (HFC's) by 85 per cent by 2036 in accordance with the Montreal Protocol requirements. Australia's phase down of HFC's began on 1 January 2018 and is implemented through the Ozone Protection and Synthetic Greenhouse Gas Program.

The Department of the Environment and Energy are now holding information sessions throughout Australia to discuss what the phase down means for HFC users, including equipment owners and technicians as well as other changes to the program to reduce emissions and increase efficiency.
