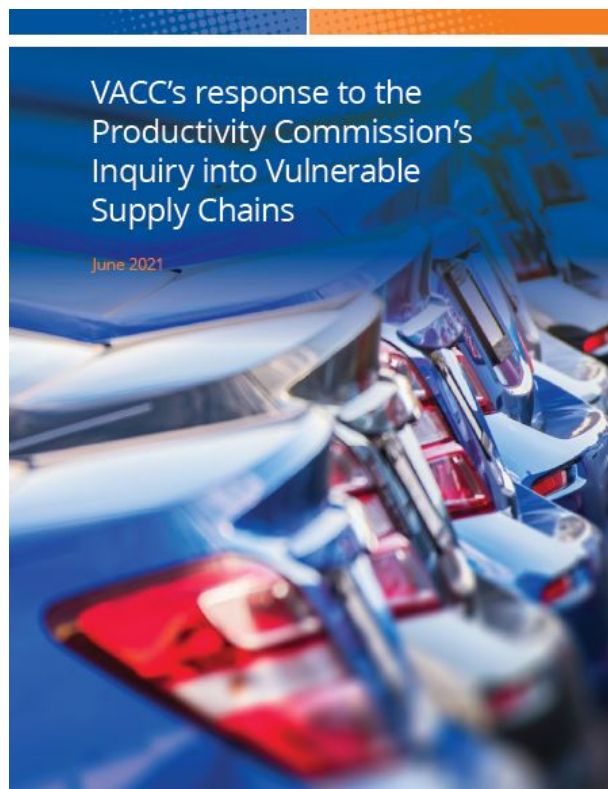

As the state hardest hit by the COVID-19 pandemic, it is through the lens of Victorian automotive retailers that the VACC submission has been compiled. Those retailers include new car, motorcycle, farm machinery and commercial vehicle dealers, independent and franchise automotive repair and servicing workshops.

The submission has presented data from VACC's Dealer Supply Chain Scan Survey and Automotive Repair Division Survey (and related interviews) collected during March and April 2021.

Many of you would know that the supply chain disruption being faced by retail automotive is seemingly changing daily. It is important that knowledge of the disrupted supply chain is constantly fed to the Federal and State Governments.
