

LVT Applications Now Open

Dear Member

Over the last few months VACC has received several enquiries from members relating to how to become a Licensed Vehicle Tester (LVT). Due to the pandemic, and the Victorian Government's stay at home orders, VicRoads temporarily placed a hold on new applications.

VACC has been advised that new applications will be resuming as of today although VicRoads has a backlog of applications to process.

Before you proceed with your LVT application, you'll need to fill out a pre-approval application and understand the requirements for your workshop.

For a site to be considered for approval it must meet the following requirements:

- test facilities housed in a weatherproof building capable of being totally enclosed and provide a satisfactory working area
- there must be unobstructed safe and easy access from the site entrance to the building entrance
- there must be adequate secure off-road parking for a minimum of four (4) vehicles
- there must be a clearly identified weatherproof public waiting room for a minimum of two (2) people
- the workshop, public waiting room and testing facilities must conform to all relevant WorkSafe Victoria and EPA requirements.
