VACC/TACC Member Information Session - Motor Vehicle Service and Repair Information Scheme Member briefing with Donny Seyfer

The Motor Vehicle Service and Repair Information Scheme is implemented from 1 July 2022.

The Government has appointed the Australian Automotive Service and Repair Authority (AASRA) as the Scheme Adviser to support the Scheme, facilitate access and streamline credential checks and other obligations and requirements. AASRA is a not-for-profit entity made up of the Motor Trades Association of Australia, the Federal Chamber of Automotive Industries, Australian Automotive Aftermarket Association and the Australian Automotive Dealer Association.

AASRA has commissioned the United States National Automotive Service Task Force (NASTF) to design, develop and implement with AASRA an online web portal to streamline access, access help, check obligations for access to security data and other related requirements.



The NASTF Executive Director, Mr Donny Seyfer, who is spearheading this work will provide a presentation and participate in a Q&A session to MTAA Member businesses on progress and how the online portal will work for technicians via a Zoom webinar on **Tuesday**, **12 April 2022 at 1pm**.
