Members are advised to take advantage of the recently deployed new version of Tech Online which now boasts unprecedented access to European repair information in Australia. Combined with the Tech Advisory service and Tech Talk publication, it is one of VACC's premier products.

An additional 270,000 pages of service, repair, and diagnostic information (more than 500,000 pages if printed), sourced from one of Europe's leading data providers TecRMI, has been added to Tech Online for the following makes: Alfa Romeo, Audi, BMW, Fiat, MINI, Skoda, Subaru and Volkswagen. Also included are wiring diagrams and technical service bulletins.

To access this resource, simply log on to the VACC or TACC website and click on the Tech Online button. You will notice a difference immediately from the previous version as the layout has changed significantly. Please ensure you delete all your old book marks, shortcuts or favorites as they may send you to the old version. The old version of Tech Online does not include the new European content. You may also be required to refresh your browser by selecting 'Ctrl' and 'F5' simultaneously on your keyboard.
