Members are advised that the payment process to consumers for the Zero Emissions vehicle ZEV subsidy that came into effect from 2 May 2021 is still to be settled with the Victorian Government. We are hoping to have this finalised in the next few weeks.

It is the VACC and AADA's preferred position that payment of the subsidy does not have manufacturers involved in the process. This creates too many touch points for the consumer and dealer to apply with any ease.

In the interim, please see the instructions below from Solar Victoria on how a consumer who has qualified for the subsidy can make an application. This includes those who have taken delivery and those who are yet to take delivery.



We're emailing to provide you with an update on what we've asked customers to do so we can start an eligibility check and the Zero Emissions Vehicle (ZEV) Subsidy payment process with them.

This applies to people who registered on our website as having purchased a ZEV on or from 2 May 2021.

This email also outlines what you'll need to ask new customers at point of sale to do when they purchase an eligible new ZEV.

For customers who have taken delivery of their ZEV

We've asked customers who have registered with us and who have taken delivery of their ZEV with a VicRoads registration to complete and submit an online application form at:

apply**

This requirement confirms that the contract of sale has been fulfilled and eligibility criteria have been met by all parties.

It's possible that some customers who have taken delivery of an eligible new ZEV may not have registered with us. We therefore ask that you please also check back in with these customers to ensure they complete the application form, if they haven't already, at: How to apply This is important for your eligible customers to apply and receive the ZEV Subsidy.

For customers who have not yet taken delivery of their ZEV

We've asked these customers to register their details with us, then wait until they've taken delivery and the vehicle has been registered with VicRoads before they apply at: [How to apply](#)

Please ensure your customers have registered their details with us, and that they complete the application upon delivery and registration of their new vehicle.

Customers must apply for the subsidy within six months of the date of purchase.

For new customers

As you'd know, Solar Victoria is working with industry to develop the subsidy payment process so that the subsidy can be applied at point of sale. Discussions on this process will take place over the next few weeks.

As this process is not yet in place, please ensure new customers who purchase an eligible new ZEV from your dealership:

1. Register their details with us at the point of sale by selecting the first check box at: [Register with us](#)
2. Read the Collection Statement (link below) while at your dealership. It outlines how we will use the information they provide.
3. Wait until they've taken delivery and the vehicle has been registered with VicRoads before they apply for the subsidy at: [How to apply](#). They must apply for the subsidy within six months of the date of purchase.

To provide this information to your customers, you can download and print this information with a QR code. Please attach this to the contract of sale as a record of the Collection Statement being provided to your customer.

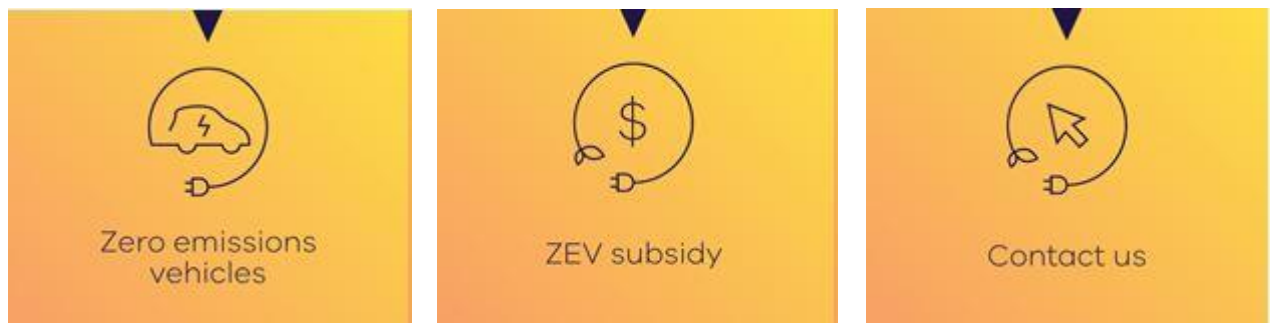
