



TSA is hosting a Recyclers Forum to help you prepare for the impending waste export ban which takes effect 1st December 2021.

The primary focus will be on providing information on changes to legislation, what you will be allowed to export under the ban (Tyre Rules) and how to apply for a licence to export.

From 1 December 2021 you will only be able to export:

- bus, truck and aviation tyres for re-treading to a verified re-treading facility
- tyres that have been processed into crumbs, buffings, granules or shreds
- tyres that have been processed into tyre-derived fuel.

The TSA Recyclers Forum is open to both accredited and non-accredited organisations who will be required to meet new obligations as part of export ban implementation.

There will be presentations from TSA, RMIT, Equilibrium, Department of Agriculture, Water and the Environment, and international representatives, including recycling equipment suppliers with opportunities to ask questions.
