Registration and associated fees from 1 July 2016

Members should be aware of new vehicle registration fees effective from 1 July 2016.

Changes and introduction to some fees

VACC has also received feedback from many LMCTs regarding 'VicRoads Dealer Certification Newsletter June 2016' where it announces an increase in the dealer administration from \$10 to \$12.50 for registration processed by dealers on the Dealer Certification Scheme. The newsletter also announced the introduction of a .04% merchant fee. The fee is applicable to registration processes (including common expiry renewals).

Members are further reminded that dealer administration fees will be matched to the Consumer Price Index as of 1 July 2017.

VACC has recorded our member displeasure regarding the new fee structures including dealer representations to VicRoads. We will continue to lobby VicRoads in pursuit of productivity gains for members.
