## Lockdown restrictions extended to City of Latrobe

Victoria's Acting Chief Health Officer has <u>announced</u>, that with the <u>exception of curfews</u>, the <u>current restrictions</u> in place in <u>Metropolitan Melbourne</u> have been extended to the <u>City of Latrobe from 11:59pm Tuesday 28 September 2021 until 11:59pm Tuesday 5 October 2021.</u>

Accordingly, within the **City of Latrobe**, the reasons for people to leave their home are now limited to:

- necessary goods or services
- care or other compassionate reasons
- exercise (which will increase to 4 hours per day), and which will be expanded to include outdoor social interaction
- authorised work and permitted education if it can't be done from home
- to get vaccinated at the nearest possible location (and other specified reasons).

The travel limit on exercise and accessing necessary goods or services in the **City of Latrobe** is now **15 kilometres from home** – or the closest location (if not within the fifteen kilometre radius).

Members are reminded that the following automotive industry businesses can continue to operate under current COVIDSafe settings within the **City of Latrobe** as **authorised providers and workers**:

- Petrol stations, including a petrol station that sells groceries
- Vehicle and mechanical repair services
- Contactless 'Click and collect/deliver' services
- Emergency repair workers
- · Roadside assistance services
- Ancillary and support businesses, where necessary for the operations of an authorised provider
- Administrative services provided by an employer to enable its employees to work from home

   e.g. payroll and IT services
- Truck stops and roadhouses, but not the provision of seated dining or shower facilities to persons who are not transport, freight or logistics drivers.
