TRADING ARRANGEMENTS IN VICTORIA AND TASMANIA EASTER AND ANZAC DAY 2020

Public holidays - Easter and Anzac Day 2020

Good Friday	10 April 2020
Easter Saturday	11 April 2020
Easter Sunday	12 April 2020
Easter Monday	13 April 2020
Anzac Day (Saturday)	25 April 2020

Trading hours in Victoria are as follows:

Public holiday	Workshops, service stations and roadhouses, towing, roadside assistance and car hire	New and used car showrooms and yards, motorcycle establishments, car washing and parking establishments, tyre retailers, boats, caravans, trailers, dismantlers and recyclers
10 April – Good Friday	May trade	 No trading if more than 20 employees working in the shop on the restricted day AND During the period of 7 days immediately before that time, the number of persons employed by the business and its related entities is no more than 100 (a full-time equivalent basis)
11 April – Easter Saturday	May trade	May trade
12 APRIL – Easter Sunday	May trade	May trade
13 April – Easter Monday	May trade	May trade
25 April – ANZAC Day,	May trade	 No trading if more than 20 employees working on the day in the shop before 1 pm on Anzac Day AND During the period of 7 days immediately before that time, the number of persons employed by the business and its related entities is no more than 100 (a full-time equivalent basis)

	IF THE NUMBER OF PERSONS EMPLOYED IN THAT BUSINESS OR THOSE BUSINESSES IN TASMANIA EXCEEDS 250 PERSONS	Service stations, the sale of motor vehicles, car yards or dealers advertising or exposing motor vehicles for sale, the sale of replacement parts necessary for essential repairs to motor vehicles, restaurants and cafes whose 'principal business' is providing meals or cooked food
19 April – Good Friday	Must not be open at any time	May trade
22 April – Easter Monday	May trade	May trade
25 April – Anzac Day, Thursday	Must not open before 12.30 pm	May trade

PENALTY RATES OF PAY

<u>Vehicle Manufacturing, Repair, Services and Retail Award 2010 and</u> <u>Clerks – Private Sector Award 2010</u>

Penalty rates of pay apply to employees required to work on the above public holidays as follows:

- All employees except console operators, driveway and roadhouse attendants and casuals employed in any classification: Double time and a half
- Console operators, driveway and roadhouse attendants employed on a full-time basis (i.e. weekly hired):
 Double time
- Casual console operators, driveway, and roadhouse attendants: Flat rate applicable to Saturday, Sunday and public holidays is payable
- Vehicle Salespeople: By mutual agreement a day off in lieu,

otherwise Double time and a half *

• Other casuals (working in any class of work):

'DOUBLE TIME' means 'single time' extra for the hours actually worked in addition to the day's wages paid for the week.

'DOUBLE TIME AND A HALF' means 'time and a half' extra for the hours worked in addition to the day's wages paid for the week.

*Double time and a half for salespersons (Level 6) means:

If more than half a day is worked, half of the salesperson's weekly rate of pay calculated as follows:

• Weekly wage rate is \$862.50, they get an additional \$258.75 (which is \$862.50 divided by 5 = \$172.50 x 1.5)

If half a day or less is worked, one quarter of the salesperson's weekly rate of pay calculated as follows:

• Weekly wage rate is \$862.50 they get an additional \$129.38 (which is half of \$258.75).
