### Initiation of Continuation Inquiry into Anti-Dumping Measures

The Victorian Tyre Dealers Association (VTDA) has received notification from the Department of Industry, Innovation and Science regarding the continuation of the Anti-Dumping Commissions Inquiry (the Inquiry) into whether the continuation of anti-dumping measures in respect of aluminum wheels exported to Australia from China is justified.
