Having your say in the 2022 VACC Executive Board elections

The VACC Executive Board provides the strategy, leadership, and governance for the association. It is the body that is ultimately responsible for the well being and longevity of VACC.

Every two years the VACC opens up nominations from the membership for the nine positions on the VACC's Executive Board. These are two-year terms of office. Where more than nine members nominate for these positions, there is an election ballot where all members can have their say and vote for the members who they feel will best serve VACC, over the next two years.

Shortly you will receive a ballot paper from the Australian Electoral Commission, and this will outline the members who have nominated for the Board and the process for voting.
