## New ADR 80/04 based on Euro VI (Stage C) requirements to be phased in

Dear member

Late last week, the Minister for Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Local Government, the Hon Catherine King MP, announced a new ADR 80/04 based on the Euro VI (Stage C) requirements will be phased in for:

- newly approved heavy vehicle models first supplied to Australia from 1 November 2024; and
- existing heavy vehicle models still being supplied to the Australian market on or after 1 November 2025.

The next step in this process will be for the Minister to formally determine the new ADR 80/04 as a new vehicle standard under section 12 of the Road Vehicle Standards Act 2018.
