Pending extension to Motor Vehicle Duty exemption for Electric and Hydrogen fuel cell vehicles

Members of the Tasmanian Automotive Chamber of Commerce (TACC) Licensed Motor Vehicle Dealer (LMVD) Divisions are advised that TACC has been informed by the Tasmanian Government that the motor vehicle duty exemption for electric and hydrogen fuel cell vehicles will be extended from 30 June 2023 to a new date of 31 December 2023. TACC thanks the members of AADA (Tas) for their resolve in seeking and attaining this extension on behalf of all Tasmanian dealers.

Important note

The extension of the exemption for electric and hydrogen cell vehicles is subject to the passage of required legislation through Parliament and Royal Assent.

In the interim, members are advised to ensure that their Dealer Management Systems be updated once the extension attains Royal Assent.
