From today, 9 November 2023, Australia's unfair contract terms regime is changing. The changes include expanding the unfair contract terms regime to 'small businesses' that have fewer than 100 employees OR turnover of less than \$10m. New civil penalty provisions for non-compliance will also apply.
